**PRESS RELEASE**

Today morning a dreaded naxal and Bihar regional committee member and rewardee of 15,00,000/- Nakul Yadav @ Jawahar has finally surrendered along with his lieutenant Madan Yadav also a rewardee of 5.00.000. Duo has been infamous for their child recruitment from tribal families and was responsible for the anti-national activities in Gumla-Latehar-Lohardagatri-junction. 46 year old Nakul Yadav @ Arjun Yadav @ Jawahar Yadav @ Bipesh @ Burha, , S/o Jageswar Yadav @ Nankha Yadav a resident of Village Joviya, PS-Kunda, Distt- Chatra, Jharkhand, was involved in many incidents like arms loot in Sildia under PS-Manatu in Jan-Feb, 1998, Arms loot from bus at Garu- Barwadih road in July 1999, Hesalang encounter with police in 2001 and encounter with police in Biju Bathan under PS-Chandwa in July-2001. Whereas Madan Yadav, SZCM, S/o Chintaman Yadav, 38 years r/o village Rehaldag, PS Bishnupur, Distt-Gumla, Jharkhand was involved in Kurumkheta encounter in 2013, Jaigir encounter in 2016, Bulbul encounter in 2016 and Bagru encounter in 2016. Their surrender has brought down the curtains of terror in the villages of Bulbul, Kerar, Peshrar and Kumari. This is a direct outcome of sustained and prolonged operations by security forces in core Area which forced them to seek safety under arms of surrender policy. Their surrender was monitored by Sh. Sanjay Anand Lathkar, IG CRPF and Sh. Ashish Batra, IGP, Jharkhand Police under the able guidance of Sh. D.K Pandey, Director General, Jharkhand Police. Other key persons involved in their surrender were Sh. Amol Bishnukant Homkar, DIG Jharkhand Police, Sh. Rajiv Rai, DIG CRPF, Sh Manish Sachhar, DIG CRPF, Manoj Kumar Gupta, Comdt. 158 Bn CRPF, Sh Karthik, S P Lohardaga and Sh. Vivek Kumar, ASP (Ops). Prior to this on 03/04/2017 evening, 158 Bn CRPF along with district force of Loharadaga was able to unearth a huge cache of arms ammunition from forest area of Vill-Bulbul, Kerar and Kotamkona, PS-Bagru, Distt-Lohardaga. However, this is part of series of surrenders which is vogue in since start of the Year. Earlier also on 24/04/17 following 10 maoist including 3 women surrendered before Jharkhand police & CRPF after getting disillusioned with Maoist aims.

These surrender of top cadres and cache of arms/ammunitions is a huge setback for Maoist movement. Particularly in Jharkhand. This Increasing tendency of surrenders of top Maoist cadres can be attributed to effective surrender policy (Nai Disha) coupled with sustained operational pressure exerted by CRPF and Jharkhand Police.
